

November 2019

Dear Friends.

The month of October has seen some ups and downs in the Parish with the joy of the Diocesan WayMark conference over two days attended by over 500 clergy and lay delegates from across the Diocese with some keynote speakers, Ecumenical observers and 50 young people. On a less than joyous note we had to cancel or at least postpone the PCC's Vision Day and S Johns Wine and Cheese evening due to insufficient support. The Harvest Festival Songs of Praise and Harvest tea were well attended Fr Mark conducted Trinity Schools Harvest thanksgiving, Fr Collins hosted the Guild of the Servants of the Sanctuary at S Johns and the Ordinand from Cranmer Hall who was due to spend two terms with us had the placement cancelled and Norman's vocational journey of exploration has ended as he wishes to continue serving in a Lay role as he has done for so many years, the purpose of vocational discernment is always listening to God's voice and responding to it. The restoration of the CELL of Our Lady of Walsingham got of to a good start in October and all are welcome to the next meeting 20th November.

November begins with All Saints Day celebrated with a joint Solemn Mass on 3rd November at 10.30am at All Saints followed by parish lunch at which the preacher will be Father

Chris Collins and at 3pm on the same day the annual All Soulstide Memorial Service at S Johns to which all are welcome. Some of us will be attending the Forward in Faith National Assembly in London on 16th November. And November ends in the Parish with the Seaham Academy Concert at S Johns at 1.00pm on 30th November.





ON THE COVER THIS MONTH

ON Sunday 13th October, John Henry Newman was canonised in a service at St Peter's in Rome. This was a momenteous day for Christians in England, as the last time an English person was declared a saint was in 1970 (the Forty Martyrs of the

reformation period). It was a day of celebration for Anglicans, as Newman started his journey as an Anglican, and he had a huge influence on the Church through the Oxford Movement.

The service was attended by the Pope and Prince Charles.

Newman was born in London in 1801, and had a brilliant mind, he was a prolific writer of letters, theology, poems, hymns and prayers as well as being an acclaimed preacher. He visited the sick and the imprisoned and those human qualities of care and friendship are as relevant now as they were in his own time.

The Vatican must authenticate two miracles to declare someone a saint. Newman has been credited with curing a man's spinal disease and a

woman's unstoppable bleeding.

Late in his life, Pope Leo X111 made him a Cardinal. He died in 1890.


